Congregate meals Monday - Friday 11:30am - 12:30pm for individuals 60+ years of age; no health or income requirements to participate. If needed, hot home delivered meals can be arranged or frozen meals are made available Monday - Friday for pick up or delivery. Call for availability.

Monthly 3rd Tuesday from 1pm - 3pm at Brookings Area United Way site. Applications are still being accepted; For those 60+ years & at or below 130% of federal poverty line eligible. Call or stop in to verify eligibility Monday - Thursday 9am - 4pm & Friday 9am - 12pm. Valid ID is required at time of application submission.
